The Fair Housing Act protects people from discrimination when renting, buying, or securing financing for housing. Did you know under the Act, a property manager cannot deny a potential tenant's application for any person who is protected by state and/or federal fair housing laws? Check out some of the protected categories which CANNOT be considered in evaluating a tenant:



Race



Color



Religion



Ethnic background



Familial status, which includes: pregnant women, families with children, the age or sex of the children



Age



Disability
